Green Cart

All Food Waste

Including:

- Cooking oil & fat
- Meat, fish & shellfish (includes bones & shells)
- Table scraps




Soiled & Non-recyclable Paper

- Food napkins & paper towel
- paper plates (un-coated)
- Parchment paper



Yard Waste

- Grass, leaves & brush
- House & garden plant waste
- Sawdust & wood shavings (from untreated wood)



Only paper or boxboard liners may be used in your kitchen bin or green cart.

NO plastic or compostable/biodegradable "plastic" accepted.



Garbage (clear bag)

Examples:

- Animal feces/kitty litter (all types)
- Cold wood ashes 
- Bandages
- Broken glass (place in a clearly marked container for pick-up) 
- Ceramics
- CDs/DVDs/VHS tapes (not cases)
- Pots and pans
- Diapers & sanitary products 
- Dryer lint
- Paint brushes
- Photos & photo albums
- Used tissues
- Vacuum bags/filters
